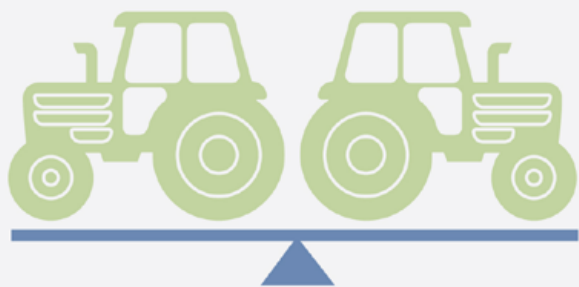
Canada's agriculture sector faces unique labour market challenges in the coming years, and so will the dairy industry.
